- **A 10% commission will be charged on all lots sold.**



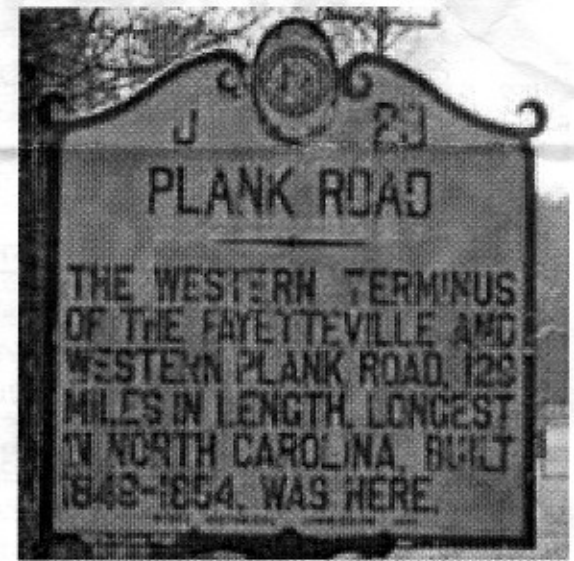
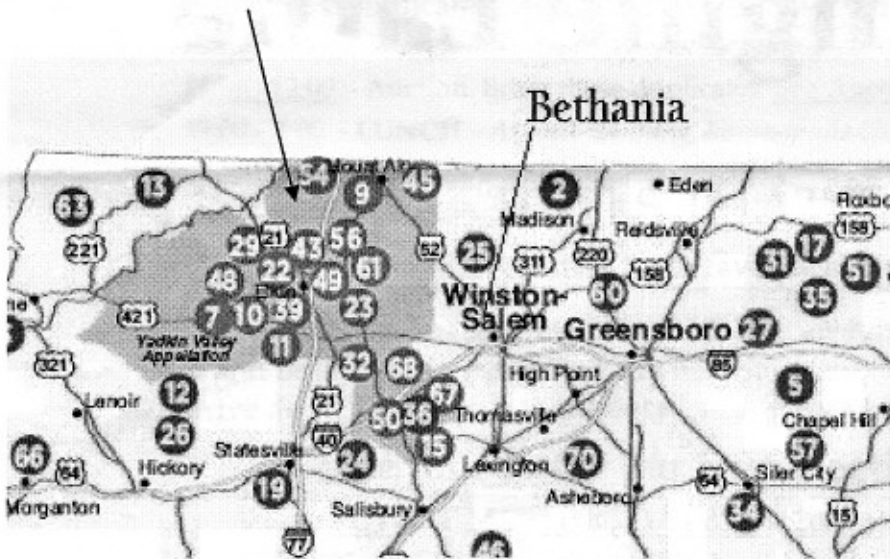
Historic Bethania Welcomes You!

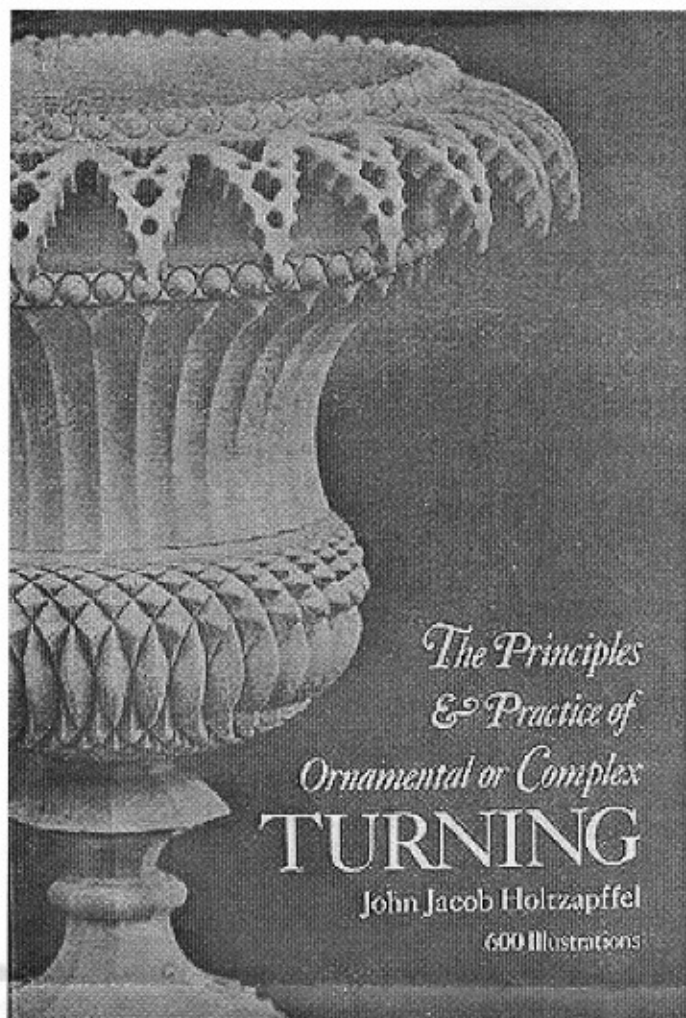


Bethania Moravian Church c. 1809
